The Hampshire Youth Justice Service Prevention Team works with young people aged 10–17 who may be facing challenges or are at risk of getting into difficulty. They offer friendly, practical support and mentoring to help young people make positive choices, build confidence and access opportunities in their community.

They can support with: Managing worries and challenges

- Building confidence and resilience
- Understanding behaviour and consequences
- Emotional wellbeing
- Education and engagement
- Access to positive activities, including arts and sports
- Support for parents and families

Beach & Water Safety

As the warmer weather continues and more families head to the coast, we would like to share some important safety advice.

Wherever possible, please choose lifeguarded beaches and encourage young people to swim between the red and yellow flags.

If they find themselves in difficulty in the water, they should try to **stay calm, float on their back and focus on breathing normally (#FloatToLive)**.

Tilting the head back and keeping the ears in the water can help, and it's important to remember that everyone floats differently.

If you see someone in trouble, call 999 and ask for the Coastguard. Staying calm, aware and prepared can help keep everyone safe.

Beach safety tips

- ✓ Choose a lifeguarded beach
- ✓ Swim between the red and yellow flags
- ✓ If you find yourself in trouble in the water #FloatToLive
- ✓ If you see someone in trouble, call 999 and ask for the coastguard
