8C on Wednesday - Chicken Goujons

Ingredients:

- 2 chicken breasts (or 450g fish fillets)
- 50g plain flour
- 2 eggs
- 2 tsp paprika
- Breadcrumbs

Thursday 7E - Grilled snack

Ingredients:

- 1 bread base e.g. roll, wrap, slice of bread, bagel, bread muffin.
- Sauce e.g. tomato ketchup, mayonnaise, pesto, pizza sauce, tomato puree.
- 30g cheese
- 3 pizza toppings e.g. onion, pepper, cooked meat.
